5). Homeowner/contractor shall verify all dimensions and job site conditions before commencing work and shall report any discrepancies to Connext if modifications need to be made.


6). Use written dimensions. Do not use scaled work.

7). Timbers- Unless otherwise noted, solid sawn timber shall be equivalent to ungraded eastern white pine No. 2 or better. Timbers shall be rough sawn, and sized to full stated dimensions (e.g. 8x8 = 8.0" x 8.0").

8). Timber screws- Unless noted otherwise, all screws shall be GRK RSS, GRK Caliburn or Fastenmaster Timberloks. Screw holes shall not be pre-drilled unless otherwise noted.
